- ⇒ Submit a one-page essay in which you address the following:
 - What are your reasons for pursuing a future in the performing arts?
 - What have you learned about yourself through the performing arts?
 - What do you think you can contribute to the performing arts?
 - Where do you see yourself after completion of your college education?
 - Submitted materials will not be returned, and must be submitted by the first Monday in April in a sealed envelope marked Personal and Confidential addressed to:
